ED STUDY NOW AVAILABLE AT PUBMED

The study-abstract of the Motil working group regarding ED treatment with PiezoWave2 is now available in one of the largest study databases

PubMed is a free search engine accessing primarily the MEDLINE database of references and abstracts on life sciences and biomedical topics. The United States National Library of Medicine (NLM) at the National Institutes of Health maintain the database as part of the Entrez system of information retrieval. PubMed comprises more than 30 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books.
